Program Overview:

This billing and coding course offers the skills needed to perform complex coding and billing procedures. It covers CPT coding for medical procedures in the outpatient setting, ICD-10-CM coding for medical diagnoses, an introduction to HCPCS coding, a brief explanation of inpatient coding using ICD-10-PCS, and basic claims processes for medical insurance and third party reimbursements. Students will learn how to find the diagnosis and procedural codes using manuals (CPT, HCPCS, ICD-10). This billing and coding program delivers the skills students need to solve insurance billing and coding problems. It details proper assignment of codes and the process to file claims for reimbursement. Additionally, this program provides students a well-rounded introduction to medical administration that delivers the skills students require to obtain an administrative medical assistant position or advance within a current healthcare career.
